- Repatriation documents

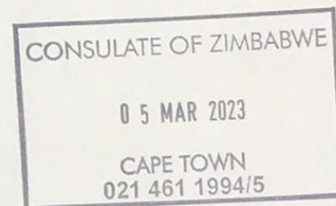
All Zimbabwean nationals who require the above listed consular services should visit any of the venues between 0900 to 1500 hours on the indicated dates. Please note that services will be provided on first come – first served basis at a maximum of 250 clients per day. The Consulate further urges all Zimbabweans accessing consular services to remain law abiding and orderly during their presence at the mentioned venues.

CONSULAR SERVICES REQUIREMENTS

<u>*Birth certificate application requirements.*</u> 1. Clinic book plus copy of its top cover (1) and copy of double page of BCG, Polio vaccination (1) 2. Unabridged Birth of SA or Proof of Birth or Maternity Certificate - bring original plus copy (1) 3. Parents' Birth certificates - originals plus copy of each. 4. Parents' IDs - originals plus copy of each. 5. Parents' passports - originals plus copy of each. 6. Marriage certificate (optional) - original plus copy. 7. R100 for birth certificate application form - those born outside Zim. R200 for birth certificate application form for those born in Zimbabwe.	<u>*Passport application for a child requirements.</u> 1. Zimbabwe birth certificate - original plus copy. Or top cover of the clinic book if the child never applied for Zimbabwe birth certificate. 2. Passport (those doing passport renewal) - original plus copy 3. One parent's ID - original plus copy. 4. Same parent's passport - original plus copy 5. Passport size photos 2 - put on dark colours (size 3.5x4.5cm - clear white background) 6. R300 for passport application form.
<u>*Passport application for an adult*</u> 1. Birth certificate - original plus copy 2. ID - original plus copy 3. Passport (those doing passport renewal) - original plus copy 4. Passport size photos 2 - put on dark colours (size 3.5x4.5cm - clear white background) 5. R300 for passport application form.	<u>*Temporary Travel Document (TTD)*</u> 1. Any Zimbabwean national document (Birth certificate/ID/Passport - original or copy). Unregistered child must apply for birth certificate first. 2. Passport size photo 1 3. R500

NB: An affidavit is required for lost IDs and Passports only.
Those with other documents in Zimbabwe will be assisted and an instruction will be written for those documents to be availed at the Registrar General's Office in Zimbabwe.
